**380 Confirmation of Minutes**

**RESOLVED:** That the minutes the Highways Committee meeting of 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2006 be confirmed and signed subject to the following amendments:

*Min 375 Cllr North is not a governor of the C of E School, so should be deleted.*

**381 Min 371 Sites for Dog Bins and Litter Bins at the Hillyfields**

**RESOLVED to recommend:**

If asked, the Parish Council would suggest that, if possible, dog and litter bins should be installed where Hillyfields Lane meets the private drive by the gate at the entrance to Frampton Court, or at the corner of Court Road.

**382 Min 372 Meeting with Mrs Chidley, SGC**

Mrs Chidley had offered various dates to meet with Cllrs.

- The Clerk was asked to check with Cllr D Hockey and accept either, 9<sup>th</sup> May (am), 10<sup>th</sup> May (am or pm) or 16<sup>th</sup> May (pm).

It was agreed that the following would form the basis of the items to be discussed at the meeting:

- a* To request support and guidance for the process of registering paths onto the SGC definitive map.
  - Prospect Lane, which was labelled path 48 on the Northavon Map.
  - Willow Way to Woodend Road, which was labelled path 50 on the Northavon map.
  - Bell Road to Newlands Avenue to join path 41 between The Land and Lower Chapel Lane.
  - Church Road to Lower Stone Close, labelled path 49 on the Northavon map.
- b* To establish if it is necessary to register the path at each end of Brookside Drive.
- c* To confirm how the Parish Council goes about getting the paths marked as currently used across the top of the Hillyfields.
- d* To discuss the need for a gate along the newly defined path 58 from Rose Lane to Ridgeway.
- e* To discuss path 13 from Perrinpit Road around the back of Poplars Farm to emerge onto the Bristol Road at new Farm.

**383 Voluntary Path Wardens**

The Chairman explained to the committee that Mrs Leech and Mr Underhill had volunteered to become path wardens. They would liaise with Cllr Hayter to report any problems they encountered such as overgrown paths, fallen trees or vandalism, which would then be reported back to the committee.

The committee thanked Mrs Leech and Mr Underhill for volunteering to do this.

- Across Lower Stone Close/Upper Stone Close.
