**237 Evacuation procedure**

The Chairman drew attention to the emergency evacuation procedure.

**238 Declarations of Interest under the Local Government Act 1972**

Cllr D Hockey declared that the participation of those Parish Councillors who are also members of South Gloucestershire District Council in both the debate and any subsequent vote on matters contained in the agenda would be on the basis that the views expressed were preliminary views taking account of the information currently available to the Parish Council. *a Min231 (c):* Bollards on the corner of Frampton End Road and Church Road- update:

Extra bollards had not been installed as no further parking problems had been reported. Street Care are monitoring the situation.

*b Min 231(d):* Proposed pedestrian refuge on Church Road

The site suggested for the second pedestrian refuge on Church Road was considered unsuitable.

**RESOLVED to recommend:**

- To enquire with Tracey Hamblett as to whether a new site had been found for the refuge.
- The Clerk to take a written response to the next Parish Council meeting.

*c Min 232: Drop Kerb at the junction of Sunnyside/Park Lane*

Cllr King reported that there was already a dropped kerb at the junction of Sunnyside and Park Lane, however there is not one at the junction of Sunnyside and Clyde Road

**RESOLVED to recommend:**

- To contact Dorrel Ferguson and ask if there had been a mistake in the junction requiring the dropped kerb.

**241 Proposed changes to Speed limit on Old Gloucester Road, Perrinpit Road, Swan Lane and Trench Lane (Review)-Comments due by 28<sup>th</sup> October 2010**

- To support the proposed changes.
- That speed on Gloucester Road would be better set at 30 mph within Frampton Cotterell's Parish boundary e.g extending from Trench Lane to Gaunts Earthcott Lane.
- That this be reported to SGC immediately due to the short time scale involved.
- To report this to the next Parish Council meeting.

**242 Proposed Bus Boarder Kerb outside 185 Park Lane**

Cllrs considered the plans for the proposed bus boarder kerb. Residents concerns had been dealt with by SGC and copies were presented to the Committee.

**RESOLVED to recommend:**

- To support the proposed bus boarder Kerb
- To write to Mark Shearman and thank him for the detailed correspondence The Clerk to clarify the date of installation of the kerb and report this to Councillors.
